

GA AAU Division I & II State (District) DQT State Championships Entry Instructions

To participate in the GA AAU State Tournaments (District Qualifiers) you must register on line. The cost is \$300 for each team – there are no extra fees added for the on line registration. You will need a credit card or a bank debit card in order to register. You may enter the team and select “PAY NOW” OR “PAY LATER”. If you want to pay later, you will have to re-enter the site and elect “PAY NOW”, select the age group that you are paying for and continue with payment. All unpaid entries will be listed. Select your entry and “PAY NOW”. **No entry will be accepted without payment after deadline.** So if you choose to pay later make sure that someone enters and pays before the tournament deadline. All information is validated during the on line process so you will need the following information before you start.

- Your GA AAU Club Number - Your Team Name -
- Your Division (Division 1 or Division 2) If two Divisions are offered for an age group – you must select your division. If there is only one division as listed in the name of the tournament, then select 0 – if there are not enough teams to have both divisions, teams will be combined into one division and all coaches will be notified
- At least one coaches must be listed on your entry with their AAU membership number – if at all possible assistant coaches should be entered so membership can be validated before event. Also team contact will receive information if one is listed.
- Head Coach – AAU number and contact information and Zip Code on AAU card
- Assistant Coach – AAU number and contact information and Zip Code on AAU card
- Team Assistant or Contact Person (this person does not require an AAU number)
 - All of your athletes –
 - Name
 - Birthday
 - Grade Exemption (Yes or No)
 - Grade
 - Jersey Number
 - AAU number
 - Zip Code – **you must enter the zip code listed on their AAU card** in order for the system to verify their number. If the zip code does not match the zip code used to register the athlete, it will not allow verification or entry.

If you want to verify that any of your athletes are eligible for any specific age group, go to www.augirlsbasketball.org and select rules.

Changes to your roster will be accepted up until three days prior to the start of the tournament. All changes must be sent with information as required on entry form to aaunichols@bellsouth.net and your roster will be edited to reflect changes. It is your responsibility to make sure that all changes have been implemented.

- The deadlines for Division II or Division I State Championship are listed on the on line registration site.
- **No changes** will be made to the schedule following the release of the final schedule.
- Remember to bring AAU cards of athletes and coaches, **copy of birth certificates, grade report or grade verification by a school administrator on school letterhead** for athletes who require exemption due to birthday/grade. Forms are on girls' basketball page at www.gaaau.net or on www.augirlsbasketball.org. If you are not sure if you need a Grade Exemption Form go to www.augirlsbasketball.org and click on rules. It will confirm grade group eligibility and if your athlete is a grade exemption. Remember to make sure that all your athletes sign in before playing in their first game. If an athlete plays without officially signing in, the game will be considered a forfeit unless prior arrangements have been made with the tournament host site director.

1. Remember that shot clocks will be used at State Championship Tournaments except for 2nd and 3rd Grade.
 - If there is a shot clock mal function – 10 second back court rule will apply.
2. All tournaments will be in accordance with Modified Super Regional Tournament Format.
3. All teams who participate can go to the AAU national tournament Division 1, 2 or 3 depending on their finish.
4. Schedules will be posted on www.gaaau.net under girls' basketball with venue sites, maps and directions to facilities.
