AAU Membership Update

AAU has experienced some difficulties with the new registration platform rsportz.com. Until all difficulties can be resolved, everyone should go back to registering at www.aausports.org - JOIN if you are a new member or select Member Log In if you are or were an existing member. Register as you have always done in the past. There will be updates when and if all issues with the new platform have been resolved. If you have already registered using the new platform, no problem, you are registered and you should be able to see all of your members by logging in on aausports.org and click MANAGE CLUB and you will see those members that you registered under rsportz platform. You can also return to rsportz and see all of your members there that you previously registered. But for now, everyone please use www.aausports.org for all registration. If any are having any difficulties at all, please contact Liz Nichols at the GA office and she will get you the assistance you need.

New – all event directors – all licenses are now free – yes free if you apply for your license a minimum of 15 days before the start date. If you do not register within the required window a late fee and expedite fee will be charged – so get those licenses done quickly. Only license the day that you will use. Do not list multiple days when you know you will only be using one day for your AAU competition. You can always change the date at no charge. The insurance carries does not want to be listed as having an AAU event run the same day as other organizational events (when there is no AAU competition). Q: What are the time limits for AAU warm-ups?

A: There are no timers in AAU for warm-ups or competition. Please follow the instructions of the meet director to ensure that the competition stays on schedule. Many meet directors will put up a clock at the first event to give coaches a guideline. Work together with your squad to ensure every athlete has time to try the equipment.

Q: How many vaults can we do in competition?
A: 2 Each athlete may attempt the vault twice. This is not required. A coach may choose to have an athlete perform only one vault.
